To implement the policy, management will:

- Promote procedures and practices which enhance environmental protection, taking into account current legislation and industry codes of practice

- Communicate clear management directions to properly motivate employees so that they perform in an environmentally responsible manner
- Educate passengers on the need to protect the environment by acting in an environmentally responsible manner
- Monitor the impact of tourists on the marine environment and adjust tours to suit
- Reduce waste wherever possible
- Design and operate the vessel as efficiently as possible minimizing environmental impact and ensuring disposal of waste is in strict compliance with regulations
- Support and conduct research on environmental issues associated with the business's activities to improve environmental performance
- Establish emergency plans consistent with current legislation and good practice
- Ensure that third parties acting on behalf of the business are aware of this policy with them
- Communicate with employees, appropriate authorities and the public, enabling the business to respond to their environmental concerns
- Monitor environmental performance to ensure compliance with this policy as well as government and legal requirements.
